Since 2010, this program has treated the side effects on the skin experienced by those undergoing oncology therapy, such as extreme dryness on the hands and feet, irritation, itchiness and tightness that affect their daily lives.

WHY?

Because having the healthiest skin possible during the illness contributes to the person's wellbeing, and can even affect job security and self-esteem. We want everyone—regardless of available resources— to be able to access aesthetic skincare treatments that are individual, professional and free of charge at their hospital or patient association.

This year we have also been able to offer the possibility of resolving any queries regarding caring for one's skin through our telephone help line and online.

Since 2014, the Project Difference program has provided support to educative teams who teach students with learning differences such as dyslexia and ADHD within the school's inclusive framework.

WHY?

Because for over 75% of children, school is their only source for resources and support, according to our experience during these last 5 years in schools.

From here, our program is directed at the teachers and the management teams in the schools. In this way, the teacher can detect the students who need intensive education support and intervene, optimizing the students' abilities.
